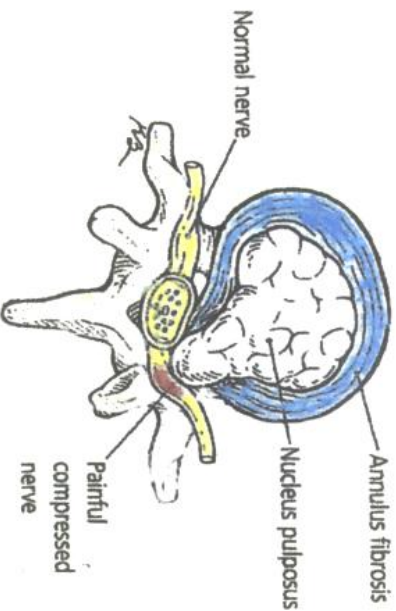


You may be a candidate for ***Decompression!***

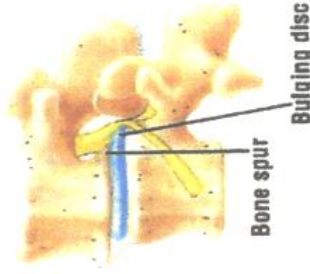

Decompression Therapy?

Spinal decompression therapy is a form of traction therapy used to help relieve back & leg pain or neck pain & arm symptoms. You may have heard or seen about decompression therapy in the newspaper or on the television.

Decompression is not new. What is new is the advancement in the procedure producing great results.

Spinal decompression therapy influences the spinal discs. The disc is the material between each of the bones in our spine. These discs act as a cushion and play a part in movement of the spine.

Decompression therapy is changing the way lower back and neck pain is being treated.

How do I get started?

An initial consultation & examination with Dr. Dragoo will need to be performed to determine if you are a candidate for spinal decompression. Your past history of your condition & former treatments will be reviewed. X-rays, MRI and other tests are of value, but may not be required.

If you are an established patient at Back In Motion Chiropractic, an examination may still be required to help determine the exact program of spinal decompression therapy that will benefit you the most.

Spinal decompression is not a guarantee that you will have complete remission of your back or neck pain. Recurrence of your symptoms are possible & additional decompression may be needed even if successful pain relief is achieved using spinal decompression therapy.
